

Reuters was nearly one-and-a-half-hours ahead of rivals on Chevron's fourth-quarter results as the second largest US oil producer reported fourth-quarter earnings below Wall Street estimates. Chevron's adjusted earnings per share of \$2.06 was below Wall Street's \$2.11 estimate, hit by weak fuel sales in the United States.
