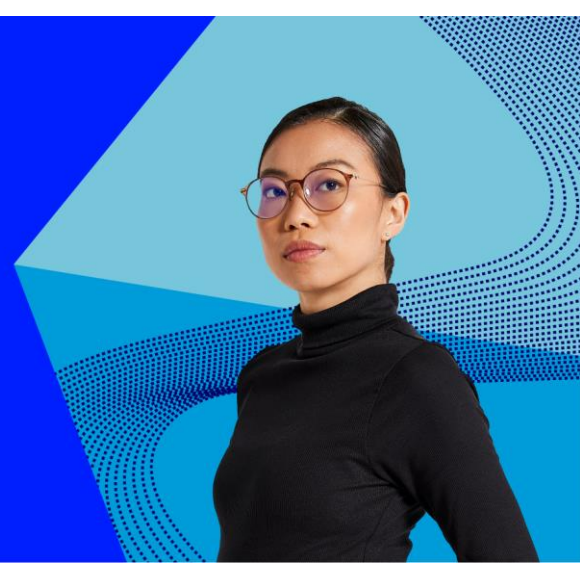

LSEG ESG Ratings Corporate Use Guidelines

LSEG ESG Rating Provider



Regulatory Information

For the purposes of Regulation (EU) 2024/3005 on the transparency and integrity of ESG rating activities, Refinitiv France SAS is the ESG Rating Provider responsible for the issuance of the relevant ESG ratings within the European Union.

This document forms part of the governance and disclosure framework supporting ESG ratings and related products distributed under the LSEG brand. References to LSEG products, methodologies, governance frameworks and related disclosures reflect the global operating framework supporting those products and services.

Purpose

These guidelines apply where a rated entity has obtained permission from LSEG to reference, display or reproduce an authorised LSEG ESG Rating in public disclosures, including annual reports, sustainability reports, investor presentations, corporate websites and other corporate communications.

For the purposes of these Guidelines, "LSEG ESG Rating" refers to any ESG rating or score issued by LSEG that the rated entity has been authorised to publish.

Permitted Use

Subject to LSEG approval and any applicable contractual terms, a rated entity may:

- display its own LSEG ESG Rating; peer ranking
- refer to its LSEG ESG Rating in public disclosures;
- reproduce approved LSEG ESG Rating values, score labels or score-related graphics supplied by LSEG; and
- describe the LSEG ESG rating as an ESG rating or score produced by LSEG.

The rated entity may only use the most recently issued LSEG ESG rating.

Disclosure Requirements

Where a LSEG ESG rating is disclosed publicly, the rated entity must provide access to the applicable LSEG ESG ratings disclosures published by LSEG.

The following statement (or substantially similar wording referencing the name of the rating) should accompany the LSEG ESG rating:

"The [LSEG ESG Rating official name(s)] of [Rated Entity] have been issued by LSEG in accordance with the applicable LSEG ESG Ratings methodology and are based on publicly available information assessed using transparent, rule-based methodologies. Information regarding the methodology, assumptions, data sources, limitations and related disclosures applicable to this ESG rating is available at [Regulatory disclosures for ESG ratings and data | Data Analytics](#)."

Where the LSEG logo is used together with an authorised LSEG ESG Rating, the rated entity should also comply with the branding requirements set out in the **LSEG Logo and Branding Requirements** section below.

Restrictions

The rated entity must not:

- alter, modify, recalculate or manipulate the LSEG ESG rating;
- present the LSEG ESG rating in a misleading manner;
- imply endorsement by LSEG of the rated entity, its products or services;
- create derivative ESG ratings based on the LSEG ESG rating; or
- use the LSEG ESG rating in a manner inconsistent with applicable laws, regulations or contractual restrictions.

Accuracy and Currency

The rated entity is responsible for ensuring that any disclosed LSEG ESG ratings are accurate, current and reflects the most recent LSEG ESG rating made available by LSEG.

Where a LSEG ESG rating has been updated, withdrawn or superseded, the rated entity should update or remove references to prior ratings within a reasonable period.

Intellectual Property and Branding

LSEG retains all rights, title and interest in the LSEG ESG ratings, methodologies, trademarks and related intellectual property.

Any use of LSEG trademarks, logos or branding remains subject to LSEG branding and trademark requirements.

LSEG Logo and Branding Requirements

These requirements govern the use of the LSEG logo when a rated entity has been authorised by LSEG to publicly reference, display or reproduce an LSEG ESG Rating.

For the avoidance of doubt, these requirements apply in addition to the disclosure requirements set out above and do not replace the obligation to include the applicable LSEG ESG Ratings regulatory disclosure link whenever an authorised ESG Rating is publicly disclosed.

You are permitted to use the LSEG logo (the "Logo") in your annual/sustainability reports and on your company website when referencing LSEG ESG Ratings. Usage outside the scope of these Terms and Conditions represents a breach of the intellectual property rights of LSEG.

You shall refrain from using the Logo on any other company materials where inclusion of the Logo could imply LSEG's endorsement of your own products and therefore prove misleading to the reader. This includes, but is not limited to:
