

How are the indexes constructed?

Constructed using a transparent, rules-based approach, each index in the Russell US State Equity Index Series selects companies from the Russell 3000 that meet defined market cap, liquidity, and state-specific headquarters criteria.

Membership	The Russell US State Equity Index Series is constructed starting with the constituents of the Russell 3000 Index. To be included, companies must be headquartered in the specific U.S. state referenced in the index name.
Exclusions	Securities with Investable market cap below USD \$500 million Securities with a 3-month rolling average daily volume lower than USD \$3 million
Weighting	Market cap weighted and capped in consideration of diversification rules
Maintenance	The indexes are rebalanced quarterly in March, June, September, and December, incorporating changes from the underlying Russell 3000 index. To support diversification, RIC 10/45 capping is applied quarterly: no single company may exceed 10% of the index weight, and companies with weights above 4.5% may not exceed 45% in aggregate.

The Russell California Equity Index is constructed to reflect California's innovation-driven economy, with emphasis on technology, consumer discretionary and media.



Russell Florida Equity index

The Russell Florida Equity Index is designed to capture Florida's economic composition, with strengths in transportation, health care and financials supported by its infrastructure and population growth.



Russell New York Equity Index

The Russell New York Equity Index is built to represent New York's diverse economy, with notable representation in financials, health care and communications, consistent with its status as a global financial and cultural hub.



Russell Tennessee Equity Index

Russell Tennessee Equity Index is constructed to reflect Tennessee's strengths in health care, industrials, and consumer services, shaped by its central logistics role and service-based industries.



Russell Texas Equity Index

The Russell Texas Equity Index is designed to capture Texas's broad and fast-growing economy, with exposure to energy, technology and industrials, supported by ongoing corporate expansion and relocation trends.
