## TRADEcho – Pre-Trade Re-architecture – Customer Dress Rehearsal (CDR)

Further to our communication on [001/17122025](#), the purpose of this Service Announcement is to provide customers with further information about the upcoming TRADEcho Pre-Trade Re-architecture CDR scheduled for **Saturday 10 January 2026**. The test will include Group Ticker Plant (GTP) market data protocol.

### Test Overview

The purpose of the Customer Dress Rehearsal is to verify that all customer applications can correctly manage the changes to TRADEcho SI Quoting and the Group Ticker Plant (GTP) that will be introduced as part of the Pre-Trade Re-architecture.

Data will be injected throughout the test to generate market data to assist with testing of the new TRADEcho GTP market data channels and instrument rebalancing across channels.

**The CDR test will include a managed intra-site component failover within the Primary Data Centre.**

SI Quotes sent during the dress rehearsal will be considered test quotes. In addition, end of day files and reconciliation files will not be produced.

10:00 – 11:00	Test window continues - Customers can start sending quotes at full production rate and volume.
11:00 – 11:15	Intra-site failover from the primary to the secondary FIX Gateway. Clients will be disconnected from the primary IP address and should reconnect to the secondary gateway.
11:15 – 12:00	Test window continues - Customers can continue to send quotes at full production rate and volume to the secondary FIX gateway.
12:00	End of Day – All FIX users will be logged out.
