The **TRADEcho Pre-Trade Re-architecture – Change Overview** has been supplemented with the following details:

- An updated schedule for the new standalone Quoting system
- Detailed use cases describing changes in the reference data publication model
- Adjustments to GTP channel bandwidth limits to accommodate higher message rates expected with the addition of new instruments. From Production Go-live, each Gateway will operate at **16 Mbps**, with a planned increase to **33 Mbps** in the following weeks.
