SOLA 9.2 Production Go-Live – Monday 28 November 2016

Following on from successful Customer Dress Rehearsal, London Stock Exchange Derivatives Market (LSEDM) confirms the go-live of SOLA 9.2 on **Monday 28 November 2016**.

As a reminder, SOLA 9.2 introduces the following new functionality:

- FIX: a number of new ENUMs for the support of PTV (Pre-Trade Validation)
- SAIL: Support for new drop copy message types, MMP Information Messages, Risk Master Switch functionality and PTV (Pre-Trade Validation) Messages.
Please note that the protocol Version has changed from A4 to A5
- HSVF: Message length changes to support millisecond timestamping,
Please note that the protocol version has changed from E5 to E6

Customers are requested to provide final go-live readiness sign-off via email to their Technical Account Manager or Technical Account Management team on londontam@lseg.com before the close of business on **Thursday 24 November 2016**.

Customers will be able to test connectivity to the LSEDM Primary Data Centre on **Saturday 26 November 2016 between 11:00 - 12:00** London time, however all trading and market data functionality will be disabled. Customers using the SAIL or HSVF protocols should ensure they login using the correct protocol version as indicated above.

Customers are advised to ignore any data that may be disseminated throughout the weekend, and ensure that any data received is removed from their systems prior to the start of trading on **Monday 28 November 2016**.
