## Millennium Functional Release 9.1 Go-Live – 3 April 2017

The purpose of this announcement is to reconfirm the go-live date of the new Millennium Exchange functional release as **3 April 2017**.

### 1.0 Changes with this release

The changes being introduced are as follows:

- Message length increased of the Native Cancel message
- Changes to MinQty behaviour
- Adding tag 851 – LastLiquidityIndicator to FIX Execution Reports
- **Turquoise Plato Uncross™** identifier on MITCH Trade messages
- Introduction of Trading Phase field in MITCH Trade message to differentiate **Turquoise Plato Uncross™** and Continuous trades
