Alternate Site Recovery Test – Saturday 14 January 2017

The purpose of this technical notice is to provide clients with notification of an Alternate Site Recovery (ASR) Test, scheduled for **Saturday 14 January 2017**.

The test involves simulating a disruption to the live service serious enough to warrant a controlled shutdown of the systems at Turquoise's Primary Site, followed by subsequent recovery of systems at the Alternate Site. The aim of this exercise is to test the following:

- the technical process of recovery and sequence of events during this process
- the process of suspension and restoration of the market
- the communications between Turquoise and participants during recovery
- the ability of participants to connect to the Alternate Site and trade as normal
- Turquoise will undertake some intraday reference data actions which will include the suspension and/or restoration of instruments.

Whilst this test is not mandatory, all clients are strongly recommended to participate as it provides the opportunity to familiarise themselves with Turquoise's ASR recovery procedures, and to confirm that their systems are able to connect to the Alternate Site and process the relevant messages generated by the above actions.
