## Production Go-Live Date for the next Turquoise Release

---

Further to the recent Turquoise Notice on 19 November 2019, the purpose of this notice is to confirm to members the Production Go Live Date for the next Turquoise release. Turquoise plans to update Production on **9 December 2019**.

The release includes the following enhancements to the **Turquoise Plato Lit Auctions™** Order Book:

- Removal of existing Primary Market Best Bid and Offer (PBBO) Price Collars. Limit Orders (non-Pegged) will be considered at their Limit Price during **Turquoise Plato Lit Auctions™** and will not be adjusted down to the Primary Market Best Offer (PBO) (Buy Orders) or up to the Primary Market Best Bid (PBB) (Sell Orders) *when applicable*.
- Introduction of new Price Collars which are designed to reject aggressive Limit Orders which are outside the Price Collars.
- Decommissioning of the Time in Force (TIF) Good for Auction (GFA).
