This notice informs customers that the 'YYYYMMDD_TRQX' files will be removed from the Turquoise CDS FTP directory effective Monday 26 November 2018.

As specified in TQ501 – Guide to Reference Data Service - the structure of the Instrument file has been modified and new filenames introduced, 'YYYYMMDD_Turquoise' in place of 'YYYYMMDD_TRQX'. These new files were added to the CDS FTP as part of the Turquoise Europe CDS Go-live on Monday 5 November, alongside the previous CDS format.
